








## Garbage & Recycle Pick-Up

Garbage Only Pick-Up



**Cart Placement:** Containers must be 3 feet apart and 3 feet from any obstruction. Walking between containers is a good rule of thumb or place one container on the left side and the other on the right side of the driveway.
